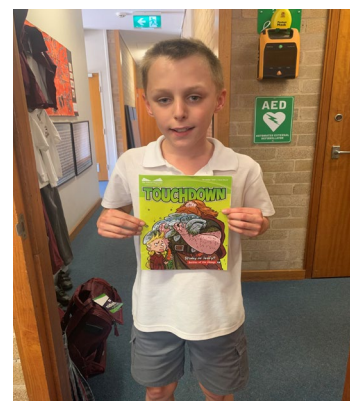

Sam Thomas 5/6 Blue, was successful with his winning entry in the 2019 writing competition.

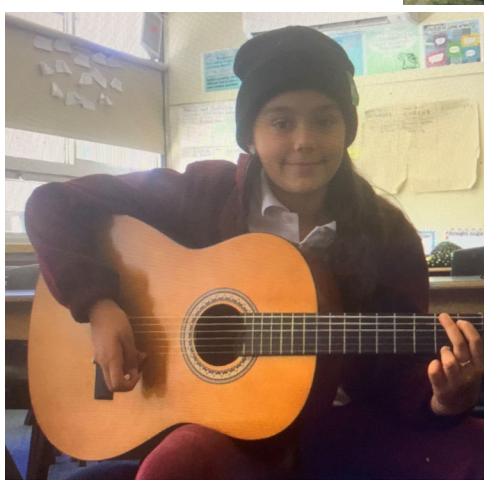
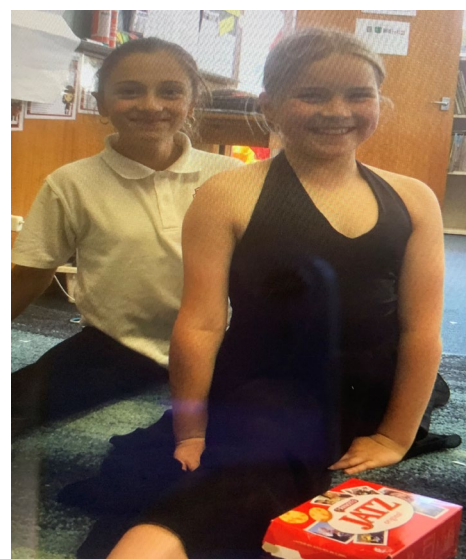
"Drop that gherkin, or you'll be sorry!" warned Desmond Snedley, his eyes flashing angrily.
